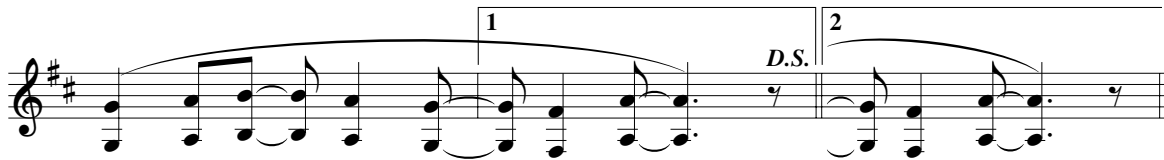

FINAL REFRAIN
