Composer Notes

“Praise to You” is a unique approach to the venerable tradition of having only *a cappella* music during Lent. We usually perform the rhythm element on bongo drums with light rubber mallets, but any hand drum will do. The feel must be kept light and brisk throughout. This piece also stands on its own as a full song as well as simply an acclamation, and it is especially fun with young people, given its call-and-response format.

This new setting of “Alleluia, Are Not Our Hearts” is another attempt* to use the Gospel acclamation as both a welcoming/reverencing of the Gospel as well as a response to the Gospel proclamation itself. “Were not our hearts burning within us...” (Luke 24:32) speaks of what we should feel and how we should respond every time the Gospel is proclaimed and broken open for us. This setting provides a very basic formula for chanting the Gospel by dividing the reading into short sections. The chanting tone works very much like a psalm tone: simply divide the Gospel reading into three- or four-line phrases and alternate between A, B, and C of the tone until the final cadence/line on D. The acclamation may then be sung again after the Gospel reading. Keep in mind that not every Gospel reading lends itself to being chanted.
