Composer Notes

This is a re-working of an old piece that was part of my 1989 collection, *May We Be Washed*, which began my exploration into different ways to employ chant sensibilities. The refrain has been simplified while retaining the chant melody of the verses. Even though it is notated as being metered, be mindful that the melody of the verses stands on its own. If it is sung with a touch of ebb and flow (*rubato*), it can still convey, in a light and declamatory style, the literal sense of this beautiful text adapted from Pope Saint Leo the Great (d. 461).
