Composer Notes

This song is based on a little known and even less used Scripture verse that serves as the entrance antiphon for Pentecost (see Romans 5:5; 8:11). I think of it as telling of the other half of Pentecost. We are so accustomed to hearing about the Spirit descending like a dove and in flames upon the heads of believers (Acts 2:3), but we rarely rejoice that this same Spirit is poured directly into the center of our being. The easy gospel feel of this piece conveys that hope-filled praise, and it works well as a thanksgiving or closing song on Pentecost and other celebrations of the Spirit, like confirmation and commissioning.
